

Delivery of donation to the hospital in Uherské Hradiště in the form
of new devices

On January 26, 2015, a major day is taking place in hospital in Uherské Hradiště. The Kapka Naděje Foundation donated one piece of the Isolette C2000 incubator with a single vital life monitor worth CZK 378,125. To purchase this device, VM Import s.r.o. and Wine Hruška s.r.o. These devices were not the only ones that were passed on that day. On the same day, the hospital was given seven more Argus 707 infusion pumps (a device that regulates the flow of liquids to the patient, enabling the physicians to have a precise and safe dose of medication) and one piece of the Argus dispenser, all of them worth CZK 242,605 .

On behalf of the hospital, the chairman of the hospital in Uherské Hradiště, MUDr. Petr Sládek, Member of the Board of Directors and Head of Economic Operations Section Ing. Vlastimil Vajdák and the head of the children's department MUDr. Jan Petrželka. Also present was a representative of the company Víno Hruška s.r.o. and also from VM Import s.r.o. The founder of Kapka Naděje was found by the founder Vendula Svobodová and Mrs. Elen Švarcová.

At the same time in the streets of Uherské Hradiště there was a collection for the endowment fund, where it was possible to contribute to the cascade amounting to CZK 20 or CZK 50. For their contribution of CZK 20, the donors were rewarded with a wine funnel and for a fee of 50 CZK they wished DARUJ ŠTĚSTÍ.
